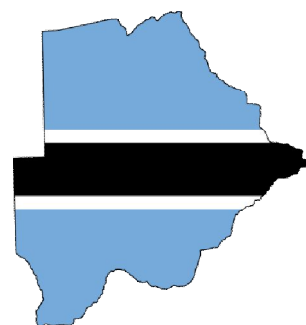

### Is this the right trip for you?

- This itinerary features some long travel days which can be even longer due to the bumpy African roads.
- Botswana temperatures rise in the summer months, (September – November) before the rain comes, to 34 - 38° C.
- Not all facilities have air-conditioning which is quite common in this part of Africa, due to inaccessible roads and lack of expertise what maintenance is concerned. As well as the fact that a lot of facilities run on generators.
- What you see on your trip may not be the same as seen by other or in pictures, due to it being a seasonal destination and migratory patterns of animals are not interrupted by fencing.
- As the early bird catches the worm, there might be a few early morning starts to make sure of best safari times or to miss morning traffic on long travel days.
- This trip is mainly lodging in 2-4 star facilities that complement the setting and location we are in. All of the chosen facilities were visited and inspected beforehand to make sure it is up to our standard.
- This trip is operated in a 22 seater luxury 4x4 bus. We endeavour not to take more than 20 people at a time. Single accommodation is therefore limited.

### Itinerary:

Botswana is becoming increasingly popular. But they do have a low impact tourism policy, meaning that they are focused on high quality service, at a high price to keep the influx of tourists and therefore the impact on the environment as low as possible. This also aids in keeping the destination exclusive. It is becoming increasingly difficult for us to allocate and confirm a big group at our usual suppliers. We may make use of alternative facilities in this case. But rest assured that they too were picked out by hand and inspected to make sure it is up to our standards and no included activity will be affected. This may however affect distance and driving time listed below the day to day itinerary.

## PRETORIA - BOTSWANA

### Day 1: Pretoria – Orapa

Our adventure begins around 05:00 from our various pick-up points as listed on page 8 of this document in Pretoria. We would like to make an early departure to miss any traffic out of the city. We will be crossing the border to Botswana at Martins Drift/Groblersburg before heading to our first destination of Orapa where we will be staying at Makumutu Lodge for our first night.

*Meals included : Dinner*

*Travel distance and time: 741km : 8-10 hours (Depending on time spent at border crossing)*

### Day 2: Orapa – Maun

After breakfast we will be driving via Rakops to Maun. On arrival you have the afternoon to yourself to maybe take part in some optional activities as listed below. We will be staying at Crocodile Camp for 2 nights.

*Meals included : Breakfast & Dinner*

*Travel distance and time: 330km : 4 - 5 hours*

Sunset Boat Cruise – BWP 160 (4 or more pax) – 690 (2 – 3 pax) p/p

### Day 3: Maun

Around 09:00 we will get into an air-caravan to enjoy a scenic flight over the Okavango Delta, one of the 7 wonders of the world where the water flow but never reaches the ocean, creating a massive marshland.

*Included activity and/or entrance fee: Scenic flight over the Okavango Delta & Park fees*

### Day 4: Maun – Nata

After breakfast we will be heading towards Nata. Here we will stretch our legs before the short distance to Nata Lodge. We will take part in a 4x4 drive into the nearby salt pans of Makgadigadi.

*Travel distance and time: 360km : 4 - 5 hours*

*Included activity and/or entrance fee: Game drive & Park fees*

## Day 5: Nata – Kasane

Today we are heading to the absolute highlight destination of our tour, Kasane. Here we will be staying for 3 nights and heading into various directions. We will be staying in Chobe Safari Lodge on the banks of the Chobe River.

*Travel distance and time : 260km : 3-4 hours*

## Day 6: Kasane – Vic Falls – Kasane

Early morning after breakfast we hop on the bus and head to Victoria Waterfalls, crossing the border at Kazungula when going and coming back. Various activities will be available for you to take part in. You can go on a hiking trip with the group (included) or you can choose to see the falls from a different angle.

## NAM/BOT 5/5

### Day 1 & 2: Windhoek – Namutoni

Our adventure begins around 06:00 from Arebbucsh in Windhoek. We would like to make an early departure to miss any traffic out of the city & to arrive as early as possible in Etosha National Park. We will be staying over at Namutoni Restcamp for 2 nights. The next morning we will take an early morning game drive through a part of the park. This is an optional activity and you can choose to sit at the waterhole or participate.

*Travel distance and time: 600km : 7 - 8 hours*

*Included activity and/or entrance fee : Etosha National Park*

### Day 3: Namutoni – Caprivi

After an early morning breakfast we will be heading east into the Caprivi. Here we will be staying at Popa Falls resort. Here next to the Popa Falls we can relax before heading into Botswana.

*Travel distance and time: 650km : 7 - 8 hours*

### Day 4: Caprivi – Kasane

Today we are heading to the absolute highlight destination of our tour, Kasane. Here we will be staying for 3 nights and heading into various directions. We will be staying in Chobe Safari Lodge on the banks of the Chobe River.

*Travel distance and time: 450km : 6 - 8 hours (Depending on time spent at border crossing)*

### Important to note:

- Single bookings can always be changed to a double / twin booking if you decide to bring a friend / partner along. A full refund will be made for the difference between sharing and single incase full payment has been received. No administrative fees will be charged.
- When booking a flight from our end destination, please consult the office via email or phone to make sure that you don't book a flight (or other transport arrangements) too early.
- The office will be able to assist in making bookings for flights and shuttles. Please note that we don't receive any flights at discounted rates. This is just an extra service we offer to make booking your holiday easier. No administrative fee will be charged to this service.

### Road conditions and infrastructure in Botswana:

Roads in Botswana and throughout Africa are often in poor condition, which makes it hard on our vehicles. We take great pride in our bus and ensure it is serviced regularly and is in a good condition, but breakdowns do happen. Some of the roads we travel on are long, full of dust and not exactly smooth sailing. This means that the travel time indicated is just a rough guide and dependant on various factors that are not always in our control. We know that it can be tough, but the destination at the end of the day are extraordinary!

### Medical & health information:

Travellers, old and young are required to be in good health in order to participate fully on this trip. We expect all of travellers to read carefully through the program and asses yourself on the stress of activities mentioned in the day to day program. If in the opinion of our tour guide or leader, any traveller is unable to participate in activities or on the rest of the tour; they reserve the right to exclude them from the activity or tour at any stage, without refund. The appropriate documentation will be provided for travel insurance.

We insist that when over the age of 75 you consult a doctor for an opinion on your travel to a particular country and /or location. All clients should consult their doctor or medical professional on information regarding vaccinations and anti-malaria medication requirements before departure. We recommend that you carry your own small first aid kit containing personal required medication and an extra pair of reading glasses. Rehydration salt, motion sickness tablets and diarrhoea blockers are also advisable to have on hand.

### **DRINKING WATER**

As a rule we consider all tap water to be not suitable for human consumption, as it may contain different levels of minerals or bacteria than the water your stomach is use to at home. Your body may not be used to this and it can cause illness. It will upset your stomach and it will spoil the rest of your trip. Many of the accommodation facilities we use provide guests with safe drinking water and bottled water is readily available throughout the trip.
